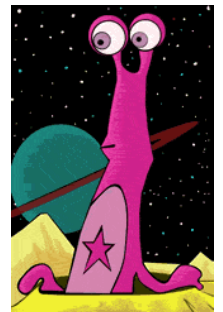


Session 3
